Glenwood (Rogers Park by Morse el stop on Red Line). *The Lady's Not for Burning* by Christopher Fry was written in 1948 at the height of the House Un-American Activities Committee hearings following World War II, although the play takes place during the Middle Ages. Written in verse resembling Shakespeare's pastoral comedies, it is a poetic, romantic dark comedy about an accused witch on her way to be burned at the stake and her great desire to live versus a war-weary, disillusioned soldier in despair with a great desire to die. Previews September 17-18 at 8 p.m. Opening night Sunday, September 19 at 7 p.m. Performances run through October 31, culminating with a special Halloween night performance, on Thursdays at 7:30 p.m., Fridays and Saturdays at 8 p.m. and Sundays at 7 p.m. Dinner package optional, starting 1 ½ hours prior to curtain. Ticket prices: previews, \$15; regular run, \$25; show/dinner package, \$45, for three-course meal served by members of the cast.
